

YARD SERVICE

RULE 32. WHEN TWO OR MORE LOCOMOTIVES ARE USED.

When two or more locomotives are use during one shift in yard service, the rate applicable to the heaviest engine on drivers shall be paid for the entire shift.

RULE 33. DINKEY ENGINES.

Engineers operating din key engines in and about shops will be paid yard rates and be governed by yard rules. Vacancies and new positions will be filled from the ranks of engineers.

RULE 34. BELT LINE OR TRANSFER SERVICE.

Yard rates will apply when yard engineers make transfers.

RULE 35. BASIC DAY.

Eight hours or less shall constitute a day's work.

RULE 36. TIME BEGINS AND ENDS.

Time to begin when required to report or duty, and to end at time engine is placed on designated track, or engineer is released as hereinafter provided.
